1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing the present CRLMC, the Petitioner against whom the allegation of robbery is made, has prayed for quashing the impugned order dated 01.05.2026 passed by the learned J.M.F.C, Dhamnagar in G.R. Case No.133 of 2021 arising out of Dhusuri P.S. Case No.53 of 2021, wherein the petition at the instance of the Petitioner under Section 311 of the Cr.P.C has been rejected.

Apart from the above, the Petitioner has also sought for a direction from this Court to the learned Court in *seisin* over the matter for permitting him to conduct further cross-examination of the P.Ws.1 to 4.

3. Heard.
4. Challenging the impugned order dated 01.05.2026, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that though



there is requirement of further cross-examination of the P.Ws.1 to 4 for proper and effective adjudication of the dispute involved in this matter, the learned Court in *seisin* over the matter did not pay any attention to the grounds taken by the Petitioner in the petition under Section 311 of the Cr.P.C and rejected the same. He further contends that the P.Ws.1 to 4 are the material witnesses.

5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further contends that since a talk of compromise is going between the parties, there is requirement of further cross-examination of the P.Ws.1 to 4 for proper and effective adjudication of the dispute. He, accordingly, prays for allowing the prayer made in this CRLMC.
6. At this juncture, learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.2 submits that he has no objection, if the P.Ws1 to 4 are directed to be cross-examined afresh.
7. Considering the submissions made on behalf of both the parties and since a talk of compromise is going on between the parties for resolving the dispute amicably, this Court while setting aside the impugned order dated 01.05.2026 passed in the above noted G.R. Case, directs the learned Court in *seisin* over the matter to allow the Petitioner to conduct further cross-examination of the P.Ws.1 to 4 in a spirit of mediation.



8. This CRLMC is, accordingly, disposed of.
