1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Mr. S.N.Pattnaik, learned AGA submits on instructions that the District Project Coordinator-cum-DEO, Gajapati has sought approval of the Government to implement the order provisionally as observed by this Court.
3. Mr. Pattnaik, requests for some more time as necessary approval of the Government has not yet been obtained.
4. This Court observes that the judgment was passed nearly a year back but still remains unimplemented without any order of stay passed by the Division Bench in the pending writ appeal. This is completely unacceptable as the litigant continues to be deprived of the fruits of the decree. The concerned authorities should remain alive to this position and act with all promptitude.



5. This Court expects the authorities should be alive to the above and act with promptitude. Time is granted as a last chance for implementation of this order at least provisionally.
6. List this matter in the week commencing 9th March, 2026 for filing of compliance affidavit.
7. It is made clear that if the order remains unimplemented and there is no order of stay, appropriate adverse orders shall be passed.
