This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners with the following prayer:

"It is therefore prayed, that your Lordships be graciously be pleased to admit this Writ Petition, call for the records, issue Rule nisi in the nature of writ of Certiorari or any other writ or writs applicable calling upon the opposite parties to show cause as to why the Declaration dt.13.10.2024 U/S 19 of the Act vide Annexure-5 and the Notice dt.27.03.2025 U/S-21(1) of the Act vide Annexure-6 Series shall not be quashed and as to why the proposed lands to be acquired shall not be denotified.



And, in the event the opposite parties fail to Show Cause or show insufficient cause, the said rule be made absolute and the Declaration dt.13.10.2024 U/S-19 of the Act vide Annexure-5 and the Notice dt.27.03.2025 U/S-21(1) of the Act vide Annexure-6 Series be quashed and the proposed lands to be acquired be denotified by the appropriate Govt.”.

It appears that an objection has been filed by the petitioners before the Collector & District Magistrate, Jajpur on 02.05.2025 under Annexure-7. After filing the objection on 02.05.2025, this writ petition has been filed on 14.05.2025.

Learned counsel for the State shall obtain instruction about the status of the objection.
