01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. The innocuous prayer made by the Petitioner in the present Writ application is with regard to a direction to the Opp. Party No.3 i.e. the Tahasildar, Begunia, in the district of Khordha, to finalise and dispose of the Demarcation Case No.83 of 2024, which is stated to be pending before him, as reflected under Annexure-2.
3. Mr. Behura, learned AGA, has no serious objection to the aforesaid prayer. Accordingly, while disposing the Writ application at the stage of admission, it is directed that the Opp. Party No.3 i.e. the Tahasildar, Begunia, shall do well to dispose of the application of the Petitioner with regard to the demarcation of the land, pursuant to the directions contained in the letters dated 24.03.2025 and 06.11.2025, within an outer limit of one month from the date of receipt of this order, without giving an opportunity to the Petitioner to approach this Court for contempt.
4. In view of the above, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
