1. Heard Mr. A.K. Jena, learned counsel for the appellant and the respondent- Ramesh Chandra Mohanty through virtual mode has entered appearance personally.
 2. The respondent-husband filed an application under Section 13(1)(i-a)(i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 before the Court of learned Judge, Family Court, Berhampur, Ganjam being Civil Proceeding No.127/2021 praying for dissolution of his marriage with the present appellant-wife that was solemnized on 02.05.1987.
 3. By the impugned judgment dated 18.02.2025, learned



Judge, Family Court, Berhampur, Ganjam allowed the said Civil Proceeding No.127/2021 preferred by the respondent-husband and dissolved their marriage solemnized on 02.05.1987 directing the respondent-husband to pay alimony of Rs.1,00,000/- (rupees one lakh) to his wife as appellant.

4. Aggrieved with the same, the wife as appellant preferred this appeal under Section 19(4) of the Family Courts Act, 1954, with a reported delay of 38 days.

5. The I.A. has been filed for condonation of reported delay of 38 days in filing the appeal.

6. Earlier notice was issued to the respondent-husband in both, the present I.A. as well as the connected appeal.

7. The respondent-husband has filed his affidavit objecting such condonation of delay of 38 days.

8. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, we have seen that the appellant-wife has shown sufficient reasons for the delay in the connected appeal and accordingly, the delay of 38 days in preferring the connected appeal is condoned.

9. The I.A. is accordingly disposed of.
