1. This matter is taken up through Virtual Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State. Perused the anticipatory bail application as well as the F.I.R.
3. This is an application under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 115(2)/126(2)/296/3(5)/351(3)/74 of BNS, 2023 in G.R Case No. 1325 of 2026 in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Tihidi arising out of Tihidi PS Case No. 171 of 2026.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners, at the outset, submitted that the Petitioners do not want to press this bail application and seek liberty to surrender before the court below and move an application for bail.
5. Considering such submissions, the Petitioners are permitted



to surrender before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today and move an application for bail. In such eventuality, learned court in seisin over the matter shall release the Petitioners on bail subject to such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper with further conditions that:-

I. shall not harass, threaten or terrorize the victim and their family members in any manner whatsoever;

II. shall cooperate with the investigation and appear before the Investigating Officer as and when his presence is required by the I.O for the purpose of investigation; and

Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of the bail.

6. It is further directed that the bail granted to the Petitioners shall be subject to the verification of their criminal antecedents as well as injury report. In the event, the Petitioners are having any criminal antecedents or the injured has sustained any grievous injury, then this order shall stand automatically revoked.

7. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
