1. These matters are taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
 2. Since these three bail applications arise out of one and same case record, the same are heard together and disposed of by this common order.
 3. These are the bail applications U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioners for grant of bail in connection with Rayagada PS Case No.259 of 2025 corresponding to G.R. Case No.509 of 2025 (C.T.Case No.12 of 2026) pending in the file of learned Additional District &



Sessions Judge, Rayagada, for commission of offences punishable U/S.310(2) of BNS, on the main allegation of committing dacoity by taking away cash of Rs.50,000/- and one mobile phone from the informant.

4. Heard Mr. S.K.Bhanjadeo, learned counsel for the petitioner-Baden Baikuntha Miniyaka @ Baikuntha Miniaka and Mr. S.K.Jena, learned counsel for the petitioner-Iswar Miniyaka and Mr. T.K.Acharya, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, however, none appears for the petitioner-Susanta Hikka, but taking into consideration the materials placed on record, this Court disposes of all the three bail applications.

5. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of the offences as alleged against the petitioners vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against them and regard being had to the pre-trial detention of the petitioners in custody since 30.10.2025 with submission of charge sheet in the meantime and FIR being registered against Purna Bidika and others, however, no TI Parade having been conducted and taking into account the other circumstances on record in entirety including the inherent right of the accused-petitioners to be presumed innocent until proven guilty at the trial, this Court without expressing any view on merits admits all the three petitioners to bail.

6. Hence, these three bail applications of the petitioners namely Baden Baikuntha Miniyaka @



Baikuntha Miniaka (In BLAPL No.4912/2026); Iswar Miniyaka (In BLAPL No.5226/2026) and Susanta Hikaka (In BLAPL No.6050/2026) are allowed and each of the petitioners is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

7. Accordingly, these BLAPLs stand disposed of. A soft copy of this order be immediately communicated to the concerned Court, who shall afterwards communicate the same to the concerned Jail through e-mail for reference.
