11. **I.A No.827 of 2026**

1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. This is an application filed at the instance of the appellant with a prayer for modification of order dated 13.03.2026 passed in I.A No.1455 of 2025.
3. Heard learned counsel appearing for the appellant as well as Mr.K.K.Nayak, learned Senior Panel Counsel for NCB-Respondent.
4. Learned counsel for the appellant at the outset contended that vide order dated 13.03.2026, the I.A filed by the appellant for his release on bail was considered and the appellant was allowed to go on bail subject to the terms and conditions as mentioned in para-11 of the order. He further contended that while directing the



appellant to be released on bail, this Court had directed the court in seisin over the matter to release the appellant on bail. He further submitted that after his conviction, the convict-appellant has preferred the abovenoted appeal which is pending before this Court.

5. In such view of the matter, the direction as contained in para-11 of the order dated 13.03.2026 be modified to the extent that “the Court in seisin over the matter” be substituted and read as “the learned trial court”. Similarly, where the word “Appellate Court” is used in para-11, the same be read as “Trial Court”.

6. With the aforesaid modification, the I.A stands disposed of.
