  1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
  2. Mr. Sarangi, learned counsel for Paradip Port Authority submits that although the Petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs.60,000/- pursuant to the direction of this Court dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 in I.A. No.6672 of 2024, but he is not paying the current dues regularly.
  3. Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner strongly refutes the same and submits that the Petitioner is paying the rent at the prevailing rate regularly. He further submits that the Petitioner will deposit the rest amount of Rs.60,000/- within a period of fifteen days.
  4. Let a further sum of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand) be deposited within a period of fifteen days, as undertaken by Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner.
  5. Put up this matter on 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2024 on which date Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner shall place on record the proof of depositing the rent in respect of the suit premises regularly.



6. The interim order dated 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 passed in I.A. No.6672 of 2024 shall continue till the next date.
