1. This CRLMP has been filed to complete the investigation as provided in Annexures-1 and 2 within a time stipulated by this Court.
2. Annexure-1 is the copy of a complaint stated to have been submitted to the IIC, Badagada Police Station, Bhubaneswar on 03.04.2025. Annexure-2 is a grievance petition which was sent to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bhubaneswar on 14.01.2026.
3. Although there are no averments in the CRLMP nor have any supporting documents been filed to indicate that Annexure-2 has



been sent/ received by the DCP, Mr. Alekh Chanda Mohanty, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that Annexure-2 has been sent to the DCP by Speed Post. He submits that he does not have the registration receipt but he is in possession of the tracking report which indicates that the grievance petition has been received by the DCP.

4. In view of the nature of allegations and the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of ***Sudhir Bhaskarrao Tambe vrs. Hemant Yashwant Dhage and Others*** reported in **2016 (6) SCC 277**, the CRLMP is disposed of granting liberty to the Petitioner to avail the alternative remedy which is available to her under law.
