1. In spite of order dated 29.09.2022 and order dated 12.02.2026 affidavit in the cases has not been filed. Perusal of order dated 12.02.2026 reveals that Mr. Nayak, learned counsel for the OPID had submitted that inadvertently the affidavit could not be filed earlier and he would file the same if he is granted one week time. He had been granted more than one week to file the affidavit.



2. In the mean while three weeks have elapsed but the affidavit in question has not been filed.
3. Mr. Nayak, learned counsel prays for one more week to file the affidavit. If the affidavit is not filed before the next date, the Officer concerned may be directed to remain physically present in Court.
4. List this case on 23.03.2026.
5. Interim order passed earlier in both the cases shall continue till the next date.
