1. Heard learned Senior Advocate Mr. Kanungo appearing on behalf of the petitioner assisted by Mr. Manoj Verma and also Mr. Nayak, learned counsel appearing for the OPID. Mr. Kanungo, learned Senior Advocate submits that the petitioner is not connected to the company, namely, GLP Developers Ltd. which has been chargesheeted as an accused along with others. Further it is submitted that the petitioner is neither a shareholder nor a Director of the said company or its employee but without any basis or justification, he has been entangled in the present case. In response to the above, the learned counsel for the OPID submits that the petitioner is associated with the company and to satisfy the Court, he wishes to file a detailed affidavit in order to show the nature of involvement vis-à-vis the petitioner and for that, prays for time, which is allowed.

2. On the prayer of learned counsel for the OPID, the matter is adjourned.

3. List on 26th October, 2022 along with CRLMC No. 4811 of 2022 for further hearing and final disposal of the CRLMC.
4. Learned counsel for the OPID is directed to file an affidavit and place it before the Court on the next date.
5. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date.
