2. Heard Mr. Y. Dash, learned Senior Advocate for the Petitioner.
3. The Petitioners have filed this Writ Petition seeking to quash the judgment dated 05.05.2022 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack in O.A. Nos. 260/00203/2017, 260/00799/2019, C.P. Nos. 260/172/2019 and 260/4/2020, by which the Tribunal has dismissed the claim of the Petitioners for regularization of service stating therein that even if it is taken that the petitioners were engaged on casual basis since 1999 as a full time casual workers, in view of the rules and law quoted in the judgment, their claim for regularization falls flat.
4. Issue notice to the Opposite Parties.
5. Five extra copies of the Writ Petition be served on Mr. P.K. Parhi, learned ASGI appearing for Opposite Parties 1 to 5 within a week for enabling him to obtain instruction and file Counter Affidavit.
