01. 1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State-Opposite Party. Perused the Anticipatory Bail Application as well as the F.I.R.
3. The present application has been filed under Section 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 by the Petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Berhampur P.S. Case No.53 of 2026, corresponding to C.T. Case No.237 of 2026, pending in the court of the learned S.D.J.M., Nilgiri, registered for alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 109/ 115(2)/ 126(2)/ 296/ 303(2)/324(2)/351(2)/74/3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners, at the outset, submitted



that the Petitioners do not want to press this bail application and seek liberty to surrender before the court below and move an application for bail.

5. Considering such submissions, the Petitioners are permitted to surrender before the court in seisin over the matter within a period of four weeks from today and move an application for bail. In such eventuality, the court in seisin over the matter shall release the Petitioners on bail on such terms and conditions as it may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of criminal antecedent of the Petitioners as well as injury report. In the event it is found by the court below that the Petitioners are having any criminal antecedent or the injuries sustained by the injured are grievous in nature, then this order shall automatically stand revoked.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
