Jurisdictional Superintendent of Police/DCP shall scrupulously serve or cause to be served the Court process and file compliance report through official e-mail to the Registrar General of this Court well in advance, failing which action follows.

Call this matter on 07.08.2026.

Caution Notice:- Non-compliance of Court's order is a punishable offence under the provision of Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and also under Article 215 of the



Constitution of India. Imprisonment is also permissible. Personal appearance of the Parties may also be directed. It is made clear that an eye wash compliance will be considered very seriously.
