1. The matter being in the list is mentioned by the learned counsel for the parties at the beginning of the days proceeding.
2. The petitioner-husband in the marriage is before this Court challenging the judgment dated 05.03.2024 in MAT case No.8/112/10 of 2012-14 passed by the learned District Judge, Nuapada.
3. The said MAT case was filed by the petitioner-husband in the marriage seeking declaratory reliefs under section 27 of the Special Marriage Act, *inter alia*,



to declare the marriage certificate to be nonest in the eye of law and not binding on the petitioner therein.

4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the parties that the matter may be referred to mediation.

5. Accordingly, it is directed that the entire case records and connected papers which would be relevant shall be forwarded to the Orissa High Court Mediation Centre.

Learned counsel for the parties shall appear before the learned Coordinator, Mediation Centre on 17.03.2026.

On the said date, the learned Coordinator shall fix a date for placing the matter before the Mediator.

6. The date of appearance of the parties before the learned Mediation shall be fixed and it shall be intimated to the parties as well as to the learned counsel for the parties.

7. List in the week commencing 04.05.2026.

8. By the next date, mediation report/interim mediation report shall be placed before this Court.

9. It is further observed that the learned counsel for the parties shall make all efforts to arrive at an amicable settlement acceptable to both the parties.
