- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.527 of 2026 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C, Basudebpur, arising out of kasia marine P.S. Case No. 70 of 2026, for commission of offences punishable under Sections 109(1)/ 115(2)/ 296/ 331/ 74/ 3(5) of BNS.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioners undertakes to implead the Informant as Opposite Party No.2.



Consolidated cause title along with requisites for issuance of notice by Registered Post with A.D to the newly added Opposite Party shall be filed by 24.06.2026.

Informant be noticed through the I.O. Extra copy of the brief for the purpose be served on the learned counsel for the State by 24.06.2026.

4. List this matter on 22.07.2026. Learned counsel for the State is called upon to obtain the case diary in the meanwhile.

4. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner Nos.2-7 (Sabitri malik, Mamalata Malik, Sukanta @ Sukanti Malik, Basanta malik, Kamala Kanta malik @ Kamala Malik and Dukhi Malik respectively) shall not be taken into custody in connection with the aforesaid case, till the next date.

In the event of non filing of requisites, by the date fixed, the interim order shall stands vacated.
