1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant CRLMP is filed by the petitioner for a direction to opposite party Nos.3 and 4, in particular to execute DWs issued by the court of learned S.D.J.M., Rairakhol in connection with 1.C.C. Case No.04 of 2024 on the grounds stated therein.
3. It is submitted by Mr. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner that the Distress Warrants have been issued but are still to be executed by the P.S. concerned, hence, the CRLMP. Recorded the response of the State in view of the order dated 17th July, 2026. But as a complaint is filed by the petitioner under Section 138 of the N.I. Act and in connection therewith, learned S.D.J.M., Rairakhol has issued DWs number of times and it is alleged that there is no response from the P.S. concerned about its execution, this Court is inclined to direct



opposite party Nos.3 and 4 to comply the same without further delay.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the CRLMP stands disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. It is further directed that opposite party No.3 shall ensure execution of DWs at the earliest preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Issue urgent copy of this order as per rules.

7. A copy of this order be supplied to the State for intimation to opposite party Nos.3 and 4 for compliance.
