1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. Petitioner in this writ petition prays for the following relief

“It is, therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this writ petition, call for the records, issue notice to the Opp. Parties and after hearing the parties, issue appropriate writ of mandamus by declaring the - disbursement of compensation amount in favour opposite parties no. 5 & 6 as illegal and further be pleased to direct the opposite parties no. 3 & 4 to redraw the award by recalculating the compensation amount under RFCTLAR&R Act, 2013 and pay the compensation amount in favour of the petitioner for acquisition of an area Ac 0.60 dec. land under Plot no. 1032/1188 corresponding to Khata No. 54 of mouza- Kebidi under Dharamgarh Tahasil in the district of Kalahandi withing time stipulated by this Hon'ble Court.



And further pass any Order/Orders or Direction/Directions as the Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper.

And for this act of kindness, the petitioner as in duty bound shall every pray.”

3. Vide order dated 18th June, 2024, learned State Counsel sought for an adjournment to obtain instruction as to why the Petitioner approached the authority for claiming compensation belatedly even though the acquisition of land was made in 1998.

4. Ms. Prachanda Mishra, learned counsel being authorised by Mr. Pradep Kumar Behera, learned counsel for the Petitioner files a memo signed by Mr. Behera, learned counsel and prays for withdrawal of this writ petition. The memo so filed is taken on record.

5. In view of the memo filed, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
