1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. This application has been filed for grant of interim bail to the Appellant, named, Ramesh Behera.
3. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits that this Appellant is in custody since 13.05.2025. The Appellant was on bail during the trial and he has never mis-utilized the liberty. He, therefore, prays for grant of interim bail to the Appellant for a certain period on any such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper.
4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the move.
5. Taking into account the submissions made and on going through the averments taken in the application; while being inclined to grant the prayer for interim bail to



the Appellant; it is directed that the Appellant be released on interim bail for a period of 02 (two) months from the date of his actual release from custody by the learned Additional Sessions Judge(FTSC), Jaipur in C.T. Special (POCSO) Case No.121 of 2021 on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper with further conditions that he will positively surrender before the learned court in seisin of the case on the date as would be so directed with further condition that he will not engage in any kind of criminal activity and will not terrorize or threaten the victim.

6. The I.A is accordingly disposed of.
