1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
 2. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner.
 3. Issue notice to the Opposite Party No.2-Informant by Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites shall be filed within a week hence.
 4. Extra copy of the bail application be served on the learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the State-Opposite Party No.1 within three working days hence, who in turn, shall transmit the same to the IIC/I.O. of the concerned Police Station to enable him to serve the same to the Opposite Party No.2-Informant in this case and also intimate his/her that this case shall be taken up in the week commencing 6th July, 2026 with regard to grant of bail to the



Petitioner by this Court. If the Opposite Party No.2-Informant has any objection, he/she may do so either engaging any counsel or by remaining present in person in Court or through virtual mode on the said date. If the Opposite Party No.2-Informant agrees to appear through virtual mode, the I.I.C. of the concerned P.S. shall make necessary arrangement for the appearance of the Opposite Party No.2-Informant on the said date.

5. List this matter in the week commencing 6th July, 2026.

6. Learned Additional Standing Counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Party No.1 is directed to obtain the Case Diary including the statement of the victim recorded under Section 183 of BNSS, 2023, if any, along with the report with regard to service of copy of such notice on the Opposite Party No.2-Informant through the IIC/I.O. concerned on the next date.
