01. 1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. The present application has been filed under Section 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 by the Petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Pattamundai P.S. Case No.103 of 2026, corresponding to G.R. Case No.222 of 2026, pending in the court of the learned J.M.F.C., Pattamundai, registered for alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 109/115(2)/118(2)/126/303(2)/3(5) of B.N.S., 2023 read with Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.
3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is submitted to the



Court by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that no injury has been caused to someone nor there is allegation of assault to anyone and therefore, the Petitioners should be allowed to go on bail. In response to the above, the case diary is made available by the learned ASC for the State so also the medical examination report of the Informant. The said report reveals that no external injury is found at the time of medical examination of the injured, namely, Sk. Mustak Ali on police requisition. The alleged incident stands narrated in the FIR. The names of the petitioners have been mentioned therein.

4. Having regard to the circumstances under which the alleged incident took place and absence of any visible injury on the person of the victim, this Court is inclined to direct the Petitioners to surrender before the learned court below for being released though not inclined to entertain his bail plea at present.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.

6. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of. It is directed that in the event, the Petitioners surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Pattamundai in connection with Pattamundai P.S. Case No.103 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.222 of 2026 within a fortnight from today, they shall be released on bail subject to each of them furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper



in the facts and circumstances of the case.
