“Under the circumstances, the petitioner most humbly and respectfully prays that the Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to declare that the allotment of land made vide order No.HO/ID/A-4379/01-02-22 dated 05.11.2022 (Annexure-15) over the same plot during the existence of the allotment in favour of the Petitioner vide Order No. HO/ID/A/4547/01-03/3665 dated 07.03.2006 (Annexure-1) void ab initio and per se illegal and accordingly be pleased to quash the order dated 05.11.2022 (Annexure-15) and subsequent steps taken, if any;

And be pleased to direct the Opposite Parties to execute the lease deed over the Revenue Plot No.66 measure Ac 1.000 in Revenue Village Bhagabanpur in favour of the Petitioner as per order under Annexure-1



for which he had already deposited the amount on 25.02.2010;

And further be pleased to pass any other order/orders as deemed fit and proper;
