01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the Anticipatory Bail Application as well as the F.I.R.
3. This is an application under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1) & 3(5) of B.N.S. in C.T. Case No.272 of 2026 in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Jaleswar arising out of Jaleswar P.S. Case No.224 of 2026.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioners at this juncture submitted that the Petitioners do not want to press this application and seeks



liberty to surrender before the court below and move an application for bail.

5. Considering such submissions, the Petitioners are permitted to surrender before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today and move an application for bail. In such eventuality, the learned court in seisin over the matter shall do well to release the Petitioners on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just and proper. Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of the bail.

6. It is further directed that the bail granted to the Petitioners shall be subject to the verification of his criminal antecedent and the injury report. In the event, the Petitioner no.1 is having one antecedent or the injured has sustained any criminal antecedent, then this order shall stand automatically revoked.

7. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
