01. 1. Mr. Pradeep Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the Appellant-Claimant and Ms. Rimjhimbala Pati, learned counsel on behalf of the Insurance Company- Respondent No.2 are present. Vakalatnama of Ms. Rimjhimbala Pati, learned counsel on behalf of the Respondent No.2 is taken on record.
2. This appeal has been filed by the Claimant-Appellant, challenging the judgment and order dated 10.03.2025 passed by the learned First MACT-cum-District Judge, Deogarh in M.A.C. Case No. 09 of 2023 directing the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company to pay an amount of Rs.4,88,800/- (Rupees Four Lakhs eighty-eight thousand eight hundred) only to the Appellant-Claimant along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of filing i.e. 27.01.2023 till date of payment. This Appeal has been filed by the claimant, for enhancement.



3. In full and final settlement of the claim, it is now agreed between the Appellant-Claimant and the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company that a further consolidated amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh only) which includes interest shall be paid by the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company to the Appellant-Claimant within a period of eight weeks.
4. The compromise memo signed by Pradeep Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the Appellant-Claimant and Ms. Rimjhimbala Pati, learned counsel for the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company is taken on record.
5. It is therefore directed that the Respondent No.2-Insurance Company shall deposit the aforesaid consolidated amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh only) which includes interest within a period of eight weeks from today before the learned Tribunal. The amount shall be invested/disbursed as per direction of the learned Tribunal.
6. As the settlement is arrived at before the National Lok Adalat, no court fee shall be levied.
7. The MACA is accordingly disposed of.
8. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
