1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. In course of hearing, attention of this Court is drawn to paragraph-7 of the additional affidavit filed by the Opposite Parties, wherein the following is stated.

“That in the meanwhile, the Petitioner has filed the instant Writ Petition before this Hon'ble High Court challenging this Ministry' order dated 23.04.2015. In this regard, it is humbly submitted that the amendment in Clause 6.1.2 of revised policy guidelines was issued on 30.12.2015 with directions to review of cases of SSS dependent pension with immediate effect. Hence, the guidelines prior to issuance of letter dated 30.12.2015 is still applicable to all cases including the case of the instant Writ Petitioner. Further, as regards to consideration of the petitioner's claim by this Ministry, necessary steps for ascertain the eligibility of the Petitioner for SSS dependent pension w.e.f 30.12.2015 to date of her death i.e 18.06.2022 is under consideration at this Ministry and arrears to this effect will be released to the Petitioner after satisfying her eligibility in accordance with the provisions of SSS Yojana.”



3. On query, Mr. Parhi, learned DSGI submits that he has not received any instructions as to the present status of the claim of the petitioner. He requests for an adjournment.
4. List this matter on 24th June, 2025.
5. Let the instructions be obtained positively.
