01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. On oral prayer made by the learned counsel for the Petitioners, he is permitted to add the informant as Opposite Party No.2. Consolidated cause tile be filed by tomorrow.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned counsel for the State.
4. Issue notice to the newly added Opposite Party No.2 by Speed Post/Registered Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within a week.
5. List this matter in the week commencing 13.07.2026. In the meantime learned counsel for the State is directed to obtain the case diary in this case.
6. Further, learned counsel for the State is directed to intimate the concerned Inspector-in-Charge, of the Police Station, who in



turn shall inform the informant that the present case will be taken up for final hearing in the week commencing 13.07.2026 and if the informant has any objection, he/she shall appear in person in Court or through virtual mode on the said date. If the informant agrees to appear through virtual mode, the concerned Inspector-in-Charge shall make necessary arrangement for the appearance of the informant on the said date.

7. As an interim measure, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the Petitioners till the next date, subject to the condition that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the investigation and shall appear before the I.O. as and when their presence is required by the I.O. for the purpose of investigation.
