1. None appears for the petitioner at the time of call.
2. Instant I.A. is filed seeking extension of time for the petitioner to surrender in compliance of the order in the ABLAPL.
3. This Court by order dated 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 while disposing of the ABLAPL allowed the petitioner to surrender and to go on bail on such terms and conditions as would be fixed by the court concerned.
