1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is an application U/S.5 of the limitation Act, by the appellant-petitioner for condonation of delay of 99 days in preferring the appeal.
3. Heard Mr. Smarajit Pradhan, learned counsel for the appellant-petitioner, Mr. Kapila Charan Nayak, learned counsel for R-6 and Mr. P.S. Das, learned counsel for R-1 to 5-cum claimants and perused the record.

After having considered the rival submissions and on going through the averments taken in IA, since the delay in preferring the appeal appears to be neither intentional nor deliberate, the delay of 99 days in preferring the appeal stands condoned, but subject to payment of cost of Rs.500/- to the High Court of
