1. Heard Mr. Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioners and Mr. Pradhan, learned ASC for the State.
 2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioners that the Opposite Parties are now proceeding for eviction of the Petitioners by loudspeaker announcement without granting him any opportunity of hearing and without following due procedure.
 3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Opposite Parties, particularly Executive Officer, Bargarh Municipality (O.P.No.3) to grant due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner and take decision in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ



petition. Till such decision is taken by O.P.No.3, the Petitioner may not be evicted from the case land.

4. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
