1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as Mr. B.K. Dash, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the Opposite Party-Corporation.
 3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that alleging non-compliance of the order dated 29.04.2024 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No.40718 of 2023, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present contempt application.



4. On perusal of the order dated 29.04.2024, this Court observes that the said writ petition was disposed of in terms of the judgment dated 14.09.2022 passed in W.P.(C) No.19346 of 2021.

5. Learned counsel for both the sides contended that in the meantime the appeal preferred by the Opposite Party-Corporation has already been dismissed by statutory Appellate Authority.

6. Mr. Dash, learned counsel appearing for the Contemnor, at this juncture, assures this Court that after dismissal of the appeal, the Opposite Party-Contemnor is taking steps for implementation of the order passed by the statutory Authority and, accordingly, sought for some more time.

7. Considering such submission, learned counsel for the Contemnor grants further four weeks' time, as a last chance, to ensure that the order passed by this Court is fully implemented.
