1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Pursuant to the direction of this Court dated 15th September, 2025, Mr. Biswal, learned Additional Standing Counsel placed on record the written instruction of Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar along with the report of the Revenue Inspector, Kalyanpur. The same is taken on record.
3. It appears from the report that due to standing crops on the land of the Petitioner, the land could not be measured properly. After perusing the report of the Revenue Inspector, Kalyanpur, this Court feels that the method, which was adopted by the Revenue Inspector for demarcation, is not proper.
4. In view of such report, the Tahasildar Bhubaneswar is directed to demarcate the land following due procedure of law in



presence of the Petitioner and other boundary tenants giving them prior notice and to place on record the demarcation report by the next date.

5. Put up this matter on 27th January, 2026.

6. It is made clear that the Petitioner shall inform the Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar as soon as the standing crops are removed and cooperate with the Tahasildar for demarcation of the land.
