- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R Case No.464 of 2026, pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Tangi, Khurda, arising



out of Tangi P.S. Case No.413 of 2026, for commission of offences punishable under Sections 351(2)/ 303(2)/ 74/ 115(2)/ 296/ 3(5) of BNS,2023.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel that omnibus allegations have been made against the Petitioners. Hence, they may be protected by pre-arrest bail

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail during the currency of investigation.

5. Taking into account the nature of allegations, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioners shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.

6. Learned Court in seisin is requested to verify the criminal antecedent of Petitioners and the nature of the injury. If it comes to the fore that the Petitioners have criminal antecedent of similar nature and the injured has suffered any grievous injury, this order shall not be given effect to.

7. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
