01. 1. Since both the ABLAPLs relate to the same FIR, on the consent of the learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State, they are taken up together by this common order.
2. Mr. D.R. Bhokta, learned counsel has entered appearance on behalf of the informant by filing Vaklatanama on 18.06.2026. Registry is requested to verify the same and tag with the file. The name of Mr. Bhokta, learned counsel be reflected in the file, cause list as well as CMS of this Court.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
4. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.491 of 2026 pending on the file of learned S.DJ.M., Udala, arising out of Khunta P.S. Case No.137 of 2026 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 109/ 115(2)/ 296/ 3(5)/ 351(3)/ 85 of BNS, 2023 read with Section 4 of D.P. Act.
5. As prayed for by the learned counsel for the State, list these matters on 21.07.2026 to enable him to obtain the Case Diary.
6. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioners shall not be taken into custody in connection with the aforesaid case, till the next date.
