- 1.** Heard Mr. P.K. Mohanty, learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. S.K. Jethy, learned counsel for the respondents.
 - 2.** Civil Proceeding No.107 of 2021 initiated by the wife-respondent and the minor daughter under Section 18(1) read with Section 20(1) of the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956 claiming maintenance from the appellant has been allowed by the learned Judge, Family Court, Angul directing the appellant-husband to pay Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) per month to the wife-respondent and Rs.7,000/- (Rupees Seven Thousand only) per month to the minor daughter-respondent No.2. The said order has been challenged by the appellant-husband in the present appeal.



3. We find from the record that we have not stayed the operation of the impugned order.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents-wife and minor daughter submits that despite the impugned order, nothing has been paid by the appellant-husband to both the respondents.
5. Since there is no stay of operation of the impugned order, it is open for the respondents-wife and minor daughter to proceed for execution of the impugned order in accordance with law.
6. List this matter for hearing in its normal due course along with connected MATA No.225 of 2023 and MATA No.226 of 2023.
