The short grievance sought to be aired in this petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India by the borrower is as to the auctioning of the security property in April, 2026. Very many contentions are advanced by learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner-borrower. However, we need not undertake a deeper examination of all or any of them, inasmuch as the SARFAESI Act, 2002 provides for an alternate and more efficacious remedy of appeal under the provisions of Section 17. No extraordinary circumstances are pointed out warranting our indulgence ignoring the availability of alternate remedy.

In the above circumstances, petition is disposed off preserving liberty to the Petitioner to avail the statutory remedy in accordance with law elsewhere and in that connection, all contentions are kept open.
