“It is therefore prayed that your lordship would graciously be pleased to admit the writ petition, call for report and issue RULE NISI calling upon the opposite parties particularly Opp.Party No.1 & 2 to show cause as to why the Possession notice dtd. 06.06.2026 and Sale Notice dtd. 16.01.2026 for demanding of Rs.46,28133/- as on 13.02.2026 by creating 3rd party interest in respect of Equitable Mortgage of Land and Building over Khata No-540/123, Plot No-570/1141 of an Area Ac 0.040 Dec., Mauza Chandpur, SRO Pattamundei, Tahasil/Dist-Kendrapada would not be set aside;

And further direct to consider the representation dtd.4.7.2025 of the petitioner for reschedule of the business loan or accept the proposal for OTS scheme;

And pass such other writ(s) order(s) direction(s) may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice and equity;

And for which act of your kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”
