1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Heard, learned counsel for the appellant.
3. Since the appellant has already filed the cheque of Rs.25,000/- towards the statutory deposit, the amount be invested in the name of Registrar (Judicial) in any Nationalized Bank by opening an interest bearing account renewable from time to time.
4. Accordingly, the I.A. stands disposed of. It is, however, apprised by Mr. S.R. Ojha, learned counsel for the appellant that deficit Court fees has already been paid on 28.08.2024.
