04. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.238 of 2025 pending on the file of learned Nyayadhikari, Gramanyayalaya-cum-J.M.F.C., Odagaon arising out of Odagaon P.S. Case No.156 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 126(2) /296 /115(2) /117(2) /109/ 303(2) /351(2)/ 3(5) of BNS.



3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that exaggerated allegations have been made against the petitioners and hence, they may be released on pre-arrest bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State as well as learned counsel for the informant opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail.

5. This Court perused the statement of the injured, Rabindra Rout and his injury report. Taking into account the nature of allegation, this Court is not inclined to entertain the application for pre-arrest bail. However, it is directed that the Petitioners may surrender before the learned Nyayadhikari, Gramanyayalaya-cum-J.M.F.C., Odagaon in connection with the aforementioned case within one month from today.

In the event of their surrender and motion for bail, the same be considered by the learned Nyayadhikari, Gramanyayalaya-cum-J.M.F.C., Odagaon on merits, in the first hour of the day.

In the event of rejection of the prayer for bail by the learned Nyayadhikari, Gramanyayalaya-cum-J.M.F.C., Odagaon, the Petitioners are at liberty to move the higher forum for bail in the second hour on the same day.



6. On being so moved, the higher forum is requested to make an endeavor to dispose of the bail application of the Petitioners on the same day.

The case diary shall be made available to the concerned courts to facilitate disposal of the bail application of the Petitioners and learned Nyayadhikari, Gramanyayalaya-cum-J.M.F.C., Odagaon is called upon to transmit the case record to the higher forum at the earliest in the event of rejection of such bail application.

Ground of parity, if any, may be considered by the learned court(s) below. The forums below are requested to verify the criminal antecedents of the Petitioners of similar nature.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
