01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.

3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer: -

“It is, therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be graciously pleased to admit the writ petition, issue notice to the opp. Parties and after hearing the parties be pleased to allow the writ petition by directing the Opp. Party no. 2 to extend the financial benefits to the petitioner considering his initial date of engagement and the period of contractual service;

And by passing such other or further orders as may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation vide Annexure-2 to the Writ



Petition, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to the Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the Opposite Party No.2 to take a decision on the above noted representation in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
