1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. By filing the present CMP application the plaintiff in C.S. No.35 of 2025 pending in the court of learned Sr. Civil Judge, Paralakhemundi has approached this Court challenging order dated 15.05.2026 passed by the learned District Judge, Gajapati, Paralakhemundi in F.A.O. No.05 of 2025, whereby the learned First Appellate Court has set aside order dated 10.09.2025 of the learned trial Court. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that by virtue of order dated 10.09.2025 the learned trial Court has granted injunction on an application under Order 39 Rule



1 & 2 of the CPC. He further contended that in the appeal preferred by the defendant-Opposite Party the order of the learned trial court was set aside. Being aggrieved by the order passed by the learned First Appellate Court, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present CMP application.

4. The Opposite Party is represented by his counsel on caveat. Copy of the CMP application has already been served on learned counsel for the Opposite Party.

5. List this matter in the week commencing 06.07.2026 for further hearing.
