1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard Mr. B.N. Rath, learned counsel appearing for the Appellant and Mr. S.K. Mohanty, learned counsel appearing for Respondent No. 4.
3. This application has been filed seeking modification of order dtd.24.07.2025.
4. It is contended that after disposal of the matter by this Court vide order dtd.24.07.2025, Appellant No. 1 died on 06.08.2025, but the share as due and admissible to Appellant No. 1 is not being disbursed to the other Appellants proportionately in terms of judgment dtd.02.02.2022.
5. This Court taking into account the fact that Appellant No. 1 has died after disposal of the matter by this Court, is not inclined to modify the order. However, it is open for the other Appellants/Claimants to move an appropriate application before the Tribunal with a prayer to disburse the share of Appellant No. 1 in favour of the other Appellants/Claimants proportionately in terms of judgment dtd.02.02.2022 along with their own share.



5.1. It is observed that if any such application is moved within a period of two (2) weeks hence, the Tribunal shall pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of two (2) weeks thereafter and disburse the amount on deposit of the same by Respondent No. 2. If the amount has not yet been deposited by Respondent No. 2, the same be deposited in terms of the order to be passed by the Tribunal, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of such order.

6. I.A. stands disposed of.
