1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. Since the appellant has already filed the cheque of Rs.25,000/- towards the statutory deposit, the cheque amount be invested in the name of Registrar (Judicial) in any Nationalized Bank by opening an interest bearing account renewable from time to time. Accordingly, I.A. No. 1669 of 2025 stands disposed of.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the deficit Court fee has already been paid. Accordingly, I.A. No. 1668 of 2025 stands disposed of.

4. The present Interlocutory Application in I.A. No. 1904 of 2025 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 has been filed by the appellant-petitioner to condone the delay of 46 days in preferring the appeal.



5. Heard. Issue notice on the question of limitation and hearing on admission against Respondents/OPs through Speed Post with AD by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice to the Respondents/OPs shall be filed within three working days. Accept one set of process fee. List this matter on 20th March, 2026.
