01. 1. Heard Mr. Nanda, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State.
2. Instant IA is filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act to condone the delay in filing of the revision for the reason stated.
3. Mr. Nanda, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that challenging the impugned order of cognizance dated 18th January, 2025 at Annexure-1, CRLMC No.1125 of 2025 was filed and was disposed of by order dated 19th June, 2025 with the liberty granted to file revision and hence, the delay, which is, therefore, to be condoned in the interest of justice.
4. Recorded the submission of Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State.
5. A delay of 68 days is reported as per the SR.



6. Considering the pendency and disposal of the CRLMC and period spent before this Court, the same is required to be condoned in view of the Section 14 of the Limitation Act. If the said period is excluded, the revision is filed within time.

3. The FIR is lodged against the petitioner registered under Sections 420, 468 IPC and other allied offences and she has been chargesheeted accordingly.

Mr. Nanda, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is sharing the household with her husband, who lodged the FIR, in view of the order of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar in CMC No.40 of 2022. It is further submitted that the proceeding seeking restitution of conjugal life is also pending disposal in CP No.256 of 2022 in the court of learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar.
