1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant CRLMP is filed by the petitioner for a direction to the opposite parties and in particular, opposite party No.3 to complete the investigation within a stipulated period.
3. A copy of the F.I.R. is at Annexure-1. Mr. Mohanty, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigation is not yet over. Referring to a copy of the representation addressed to opposite party No.2 as at Annexure-2, the further submission is that there is undue delay in the closure of investigation.
4. Recorded the submission of Mr. Panda, learned ASC for the State according to whom the offences are bailable in nature. The instructions received from the IIC of the P.S. concerned is also submitted to the Court by Mr. Panda, learned ASC to claim that the chargesheet is already filed. A copy of the said intimation to the office of the learned AG, Odisha is produced at the time of hearing. In view of the above and since



the chargesheet is already filed, no further direction is necessary.

5. Accordingly, it is ordered.
6. Consequently, the CRLMP stands disposed of.
