1. This is an application by the petitioner No.1-Alex Raj Pani for grant of interim bail to attend his pregnant wife, who is supposed to give birth on 7th July, 2026.

2. Heard, Mr. Bhabani Shankar Tripathy, learned Senior Counsel, who is being assisted by Mr. Atul Tripathy, learned counsel for the petitioner No.1 and Mr. T.K. Acharya, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the matter and perused the record.

3. After having considered the rival submissions and on going through the materials placed on record together with the documents annexed thereto, since there appears no urgency in the matter, this Court does not consider it proper to grant interim bail to the petitioner No.1.
