1. Heard Mr. G.N. Parida, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. G. Tripathy, learned Additional Government Advocate for State-Opposite Parties.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that after disposal of OPLE Appeal No.69 of 2026 on 05.06.2026 by the Sub-Collector, the certified copy of the same has not been granted to the Petitioner despite his copy application is pending since 08.06.2026. But on the other hand, the Tahasildar is proceeding for eviction of the Petitioner from the case land.
3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sub-Collector, Bhadrak (Opposite Party No.3) to grant certified copy of the final order passed in OPLE Appeal No.69 of 2026, as per the acknowledgement receipt of copy application at Annexure-3, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition.



4. The Petitioner is granted further thirty (30) days' time to prefer revision against the same, as submitted on behalf of the Petitioner. In the event, the Petitioner prefers revision within such period as stated above, no eviction shall be effected for a period of forty-five (45) days from today, or till filing of the revision, whichever is earlier.

5. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
