1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned ASC for the State.

2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed for pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with B. Bazar P.S. Case No.304 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1252 of 2026 pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M., Berhampur, Ganjam on the grounds stated therein.

3. Perused the FIR as at Annexure-1. The name of the petitioner is mentioned in the FIR. It is alleged therein that the petitioner and two others committed the alleged mischief and snatched away a gold chain and cash of Rs.5,000/- from the informant. The manner in which the alleged incident took place has been narrated in the FIR. Mr. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was rather an attempt to commit robbery. Recorded the objection of the State. The FIR reveals



that the informant was assaulted by the petitioner causing injury to him. On being asked, Mr. Das, learned counsel informed the Court that the petitioner has two antecedents and one is of similar in nature. Considering the submissions of learned counsel for the respective parties and the nature of allegations, this Court though not in favour of entertaining the bail plea of the petitioner, however, is of the view that he should be directed to surrender before the learned court below for being released with stringent conditions.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL stands disposed of. It is directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders before the learned S.D.J.M., Berhampur, Ganjam in connection with B. Bazar P.S. Case No.304 of 2026 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1252 of 2026 within a period of fifteen days from today, he shall be released on bail subject to him furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned court below, which shall be at liberty to impose such other suitable conditions as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and subject to verification and absence of not more than two cases and at the same time, to attend the PS concerned once in a fortnight preferably on Sunday and to continue to do so till the investigation is over.
