1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. It is stated by learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party-Contemnor that the deceased government employee, while he was in service, took voluntary retirement and in his place, his son was appointed on compassionate ground under the OCS (RA) Rules, 1990. He further contended that now the daughter of the deceased government employee has approached this Court seeking appointment on compassionate ground. However, such fact is not on the record.
3. On the request of learned counsel for the Contemnor, he is granted two weeks' time to bring such facts on record by filing an affidavit after serving a copy thereof on learned counsel for the Petitioner.



4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner shall file his objection, if any, to such affidavit.
5. Let the affidavit by the Contemnor-Opposite Party be filed by 31.07.2026, whereafter, the Petitioner shall file his objection within ten days.
6. List this matter on 14.08.2026.
