1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer;

“It is, therefore prayed that Your Lordships would be graciously pleased to admit the Writ Petition and issue Rule NISI to the opposite parties and if the opposite parties fail to show cause or show insufficient cause made the said Rule absolute by directing the opposite party No.3 to issue record of right in favour of the petitioner depicting the nature of holding as sthitiban;

And/or pass any Writ(s), direction(s), order(s) as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper.
